HEAD TEACHER'S MESSAGE TO THE CHILDREN:

It has been another good week in school and our classes are now well settled into normal routines. We have welcomed back sports coaches and music teachers and the children have thoroughly enjoyed it!

Thank you to those who joined us on Monday for the curriculum information evenings. We hope you found those useful, if you need to refer back for any information they have been shared via your child's google classroom platform.

This week is our launch of *Doodle* for the children's weekly homework. Doodle's online Parent and Teacher Dashboards let adults track each child's progress across all of the Doodle programmes. From the Dashboards, parents and teachers can see how many stars learners have earned, as well as their current streak and DoodleAge. But the Dashboards go well beyond this. They also show where each child's learning gaps are in the curriculum, making it easy to see where they need a little more support. You will have received the login information for your child and also further details for parents to download the 'dashboard' to your mobile devices. If you have problems please let your child's class teacher know. In the coming weeks we will be offering further curriculum support evenings for parents including; top tips for reading at home, maths reinforcement and also phonics sessions. We will continue to offer these as google meetings so parents who are available can join us or you can log into google classroom and watch at a later convenient time. We will share google meet links via your marvellous me messages.

Our celebration assemblies have resumed on a Friday afternoon, this is the opportunity for the children to come together and celebrate the successes of the week. We will be handing out our 'Kid Awesome awards' and also Head Teacher certificates. If your child takes part in any activities outside of school and would like to bring in medals or certificates we would be happy to share this on a Friday as a whole school.

In other news, Gavin Williamson has been relieved of his duties as Education Secretary. The new appointment is Nadhim Zawahi who has previously held the position of Secretary of State for Children and Families. I sincerely hope that he can cut through some of the 'political red tape' and put our children at the heart of Government policy!

Parents will be informed of the outcome of their application on Offer Day, Monday 1st March 2021.




Childrens' Cancer Run:

will see a number of changes to make it as safe as possible for all of the runners, staff and volunteers:

- Reduced numbers on site we have only released 4000 run places and will be staggering the start over a longer period to allow more space on site.
- All run packs will be sent to runner's home addresses, including the children's t-shirts.
