

SALTO UNIFORM ORDER DEADLINE AND NEW PE KIT:

We sent a parentmail this week letting you know that the deadline for placing guaranteed orders for September with Salto, our branded uniform supplier, is Friday 15th July.

This is their busiest time of year and with current supply chain issues they do need to have orders placed in good time.

We would also like to let you know that Salto will be supplying a new PE kit for us, which consists of a navy polo shirt and shorts, along with the existing PE hoody. This will replace the current gold t-shirt. We will be phasing this new kit in - so our new Reception class starters in September will be using it from the start of their time at Whittonstall. For all other year groups however, we would not expect you to purchase this unless you were buying new PE clothes anyway as your child has outgrown their current kit.

Years 3 & 4 will be attending a sports event at Corbridge Middle School on the afternoon of Friday 20th May. The event is a School Games area qualifier for the County Quad Kids final which will take place in the second half of the summer term, if our teams are successful in qualifying. It is an opportunity for every Class 3 pupil to participate in the School Games and represent their school whilst also experiencing the environment of the middle school which many of the Year 4 pupils will transition to

next year. The event will be overseen by Helen Robson from Active Northumberland School Sport Partnership. The activities include:

50m sprint

400m run

Howler throw from standing - overarm throw with no run up

Standing Broad Jump - two feet to feet jump with no run up

The two winning Tynedale schools will be invited to attend the County/ level 3 event to represent Tynedale.

Could the children please attend school in their PE kits on Friday and bring a waterproof and water bottle. We will be travelling to and from Corbridge by coach. The children will have a slightly early lunch at school before setting off.
