HEAD TEACHER'S MESSAGE:

These are exciting times for our Year 4 children. They had some special visitors from Corbridge Middle School on Tuesday this week as part of the transition to their new school. This was an opportunity to start to get to know the Corbridge staff, learn more about the school and ask any burning questions they may have had. Next week is their much anticipated residential visit to Ford Castle, where we know they will have a fantastic experience and make memories to cherish. It is great to be able to get the children out and about again and enjoying these vital learning experiences. We are so proud of our Year 4 children as they prepare to move on to the next phase of their school career.

This week we have had new smart board technology installed in all the classrooms at Whittonstall and Broomley. This is part of an exciting ICT strategy that we have been working on over the past year to enhance and upgrade the IT infrastructure in our schools.
